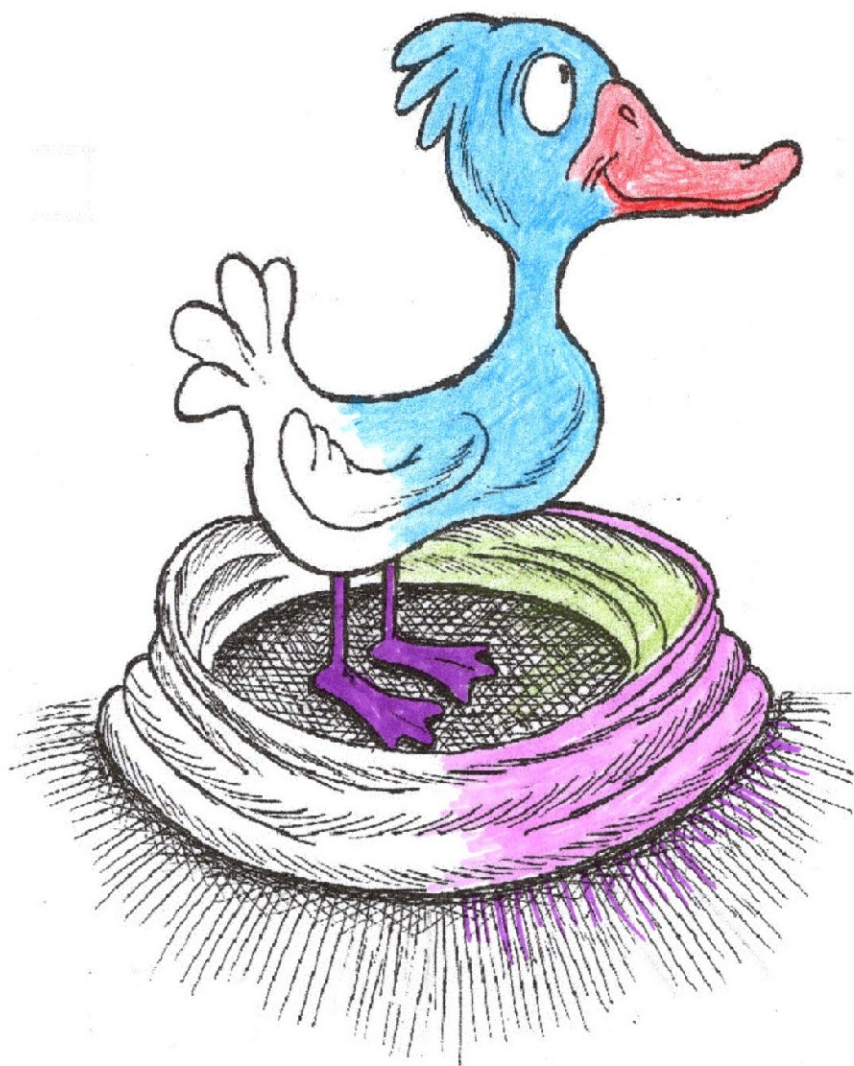

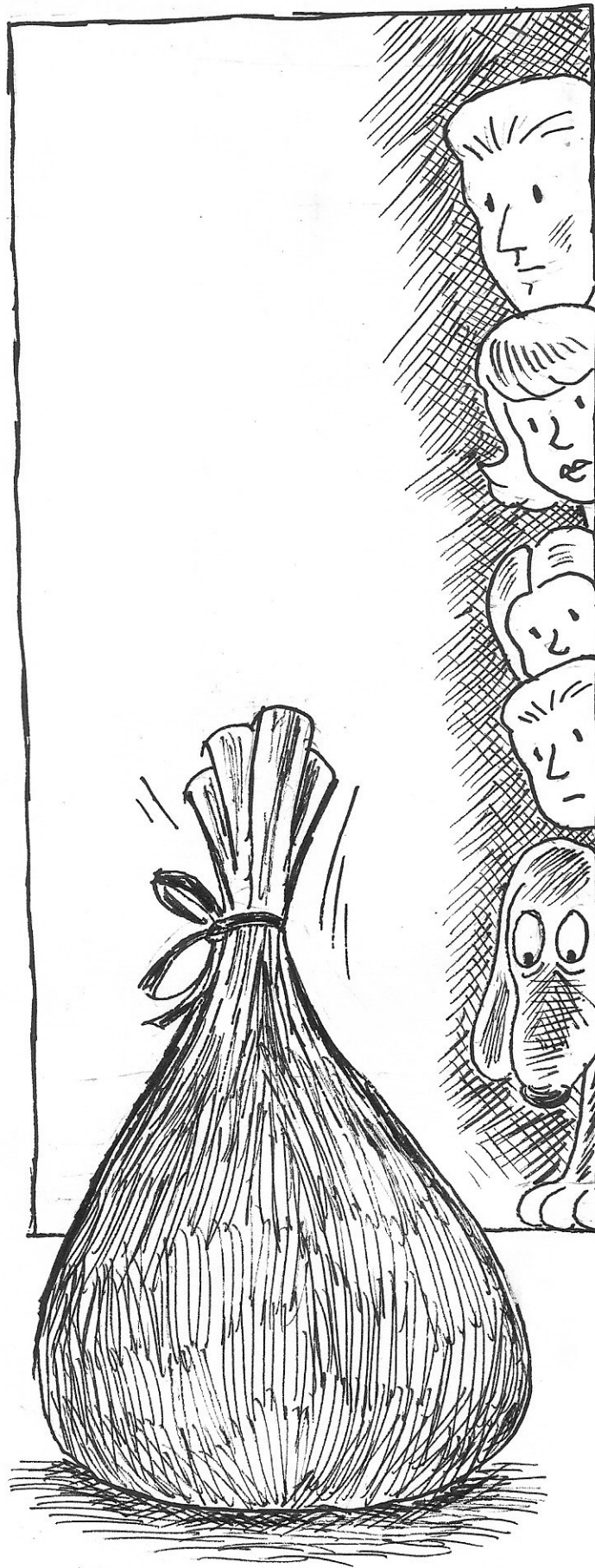

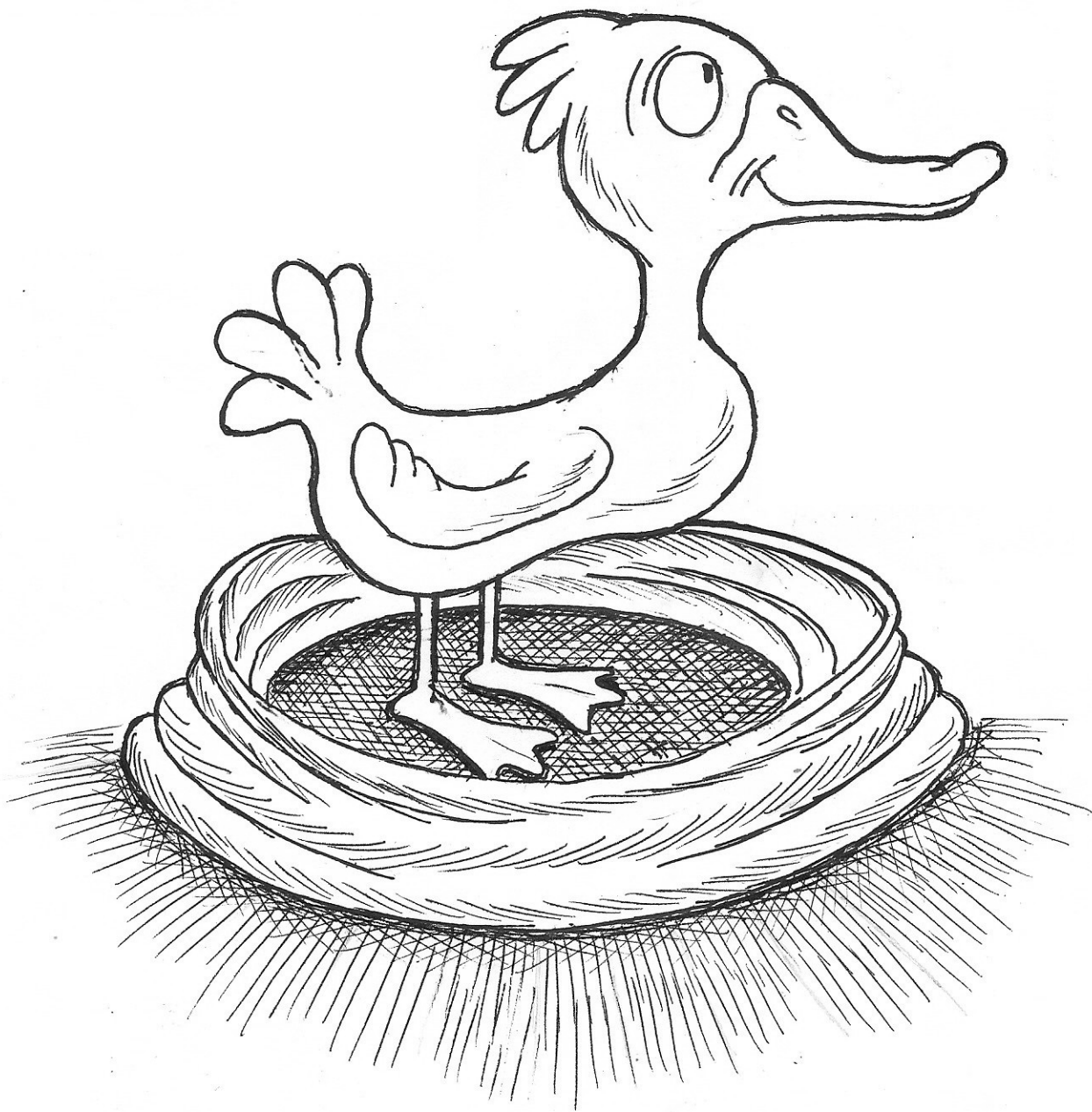
One day we heard a loud WHACK! WHACK!



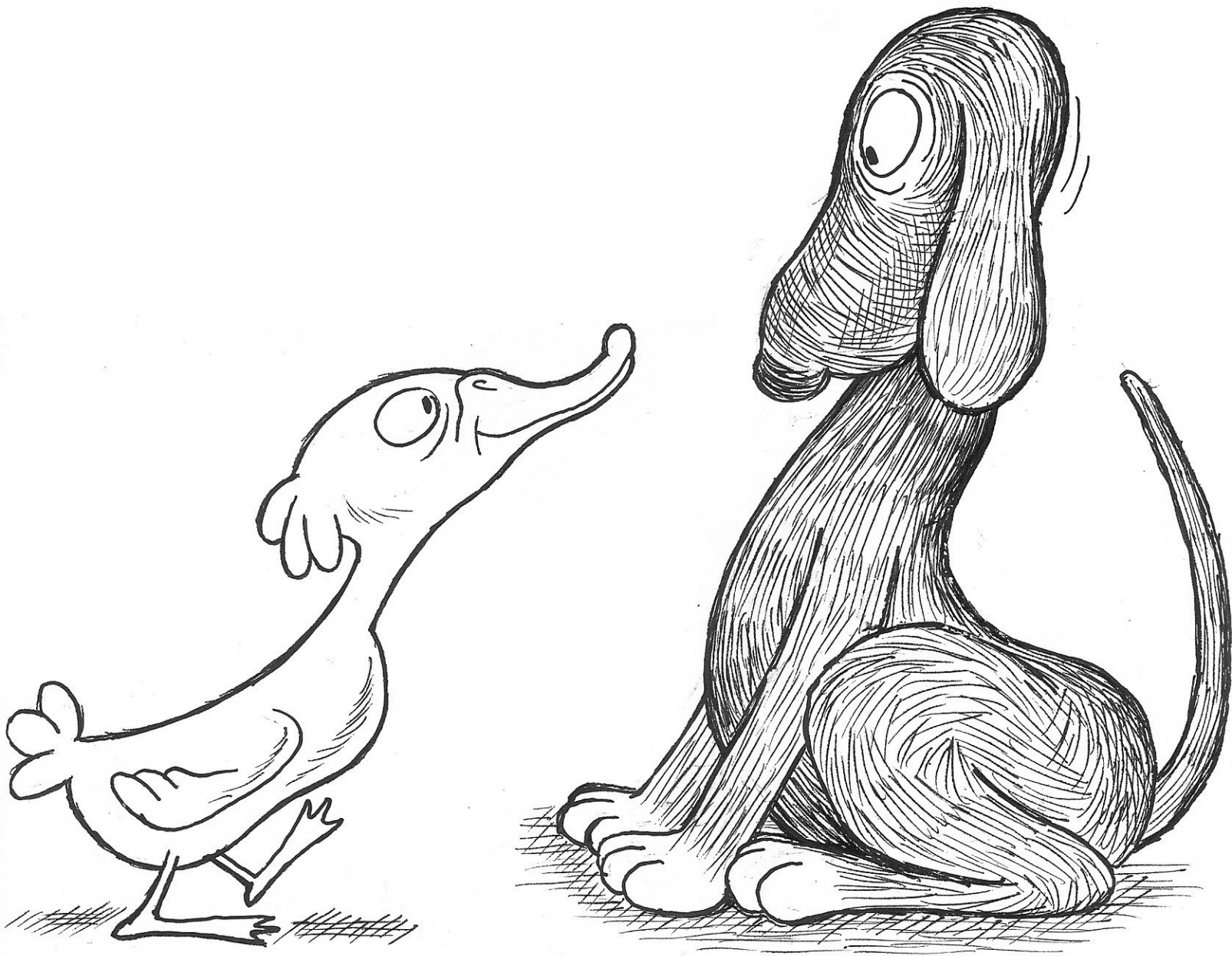
And there on the porch was a large black sack.



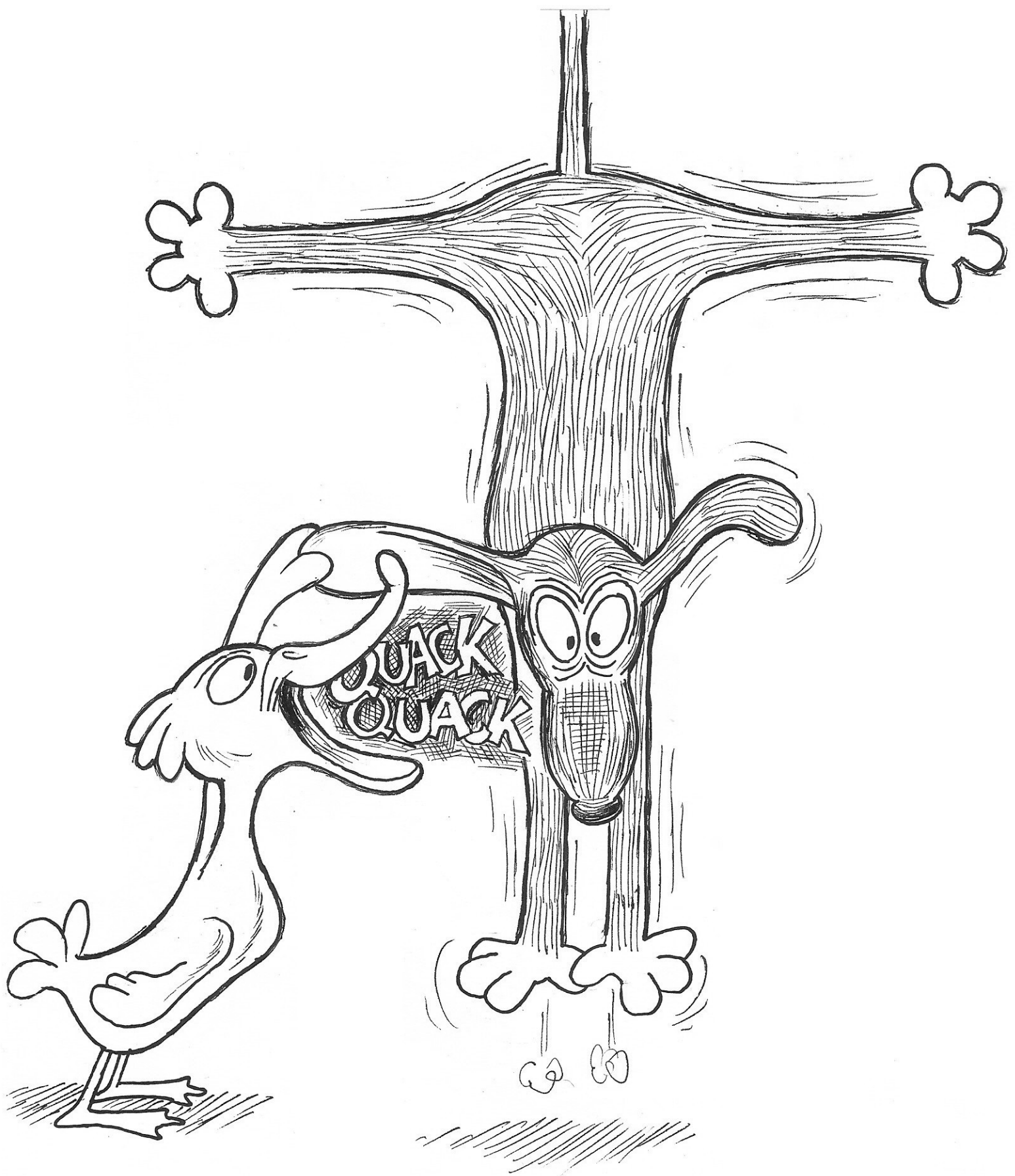
When we picked it up, it went, "QUACK! QUACK!"



So that's how we met our duck, Jack Quack.



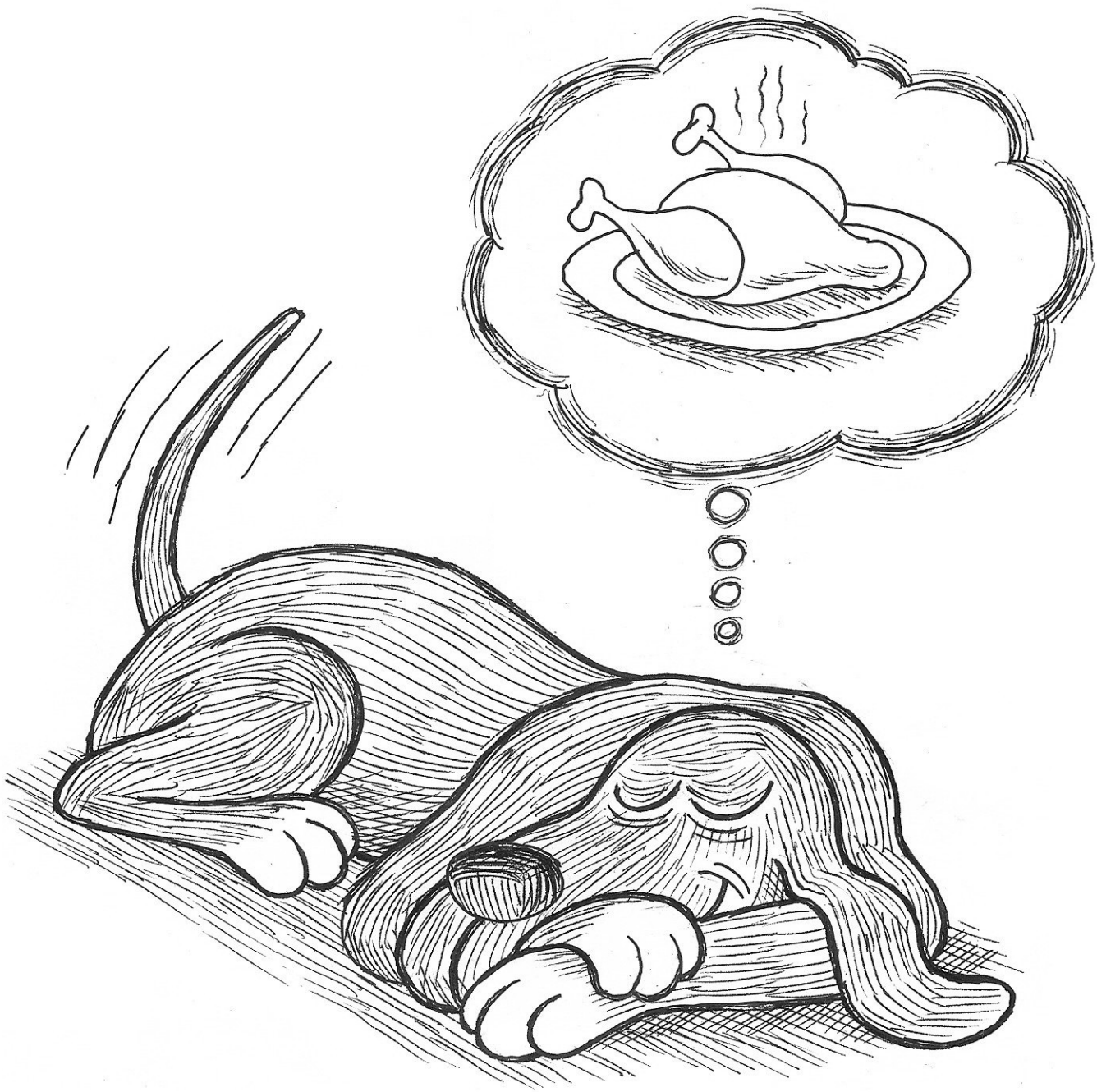
The first thing he saw was our dog, Black Mack.



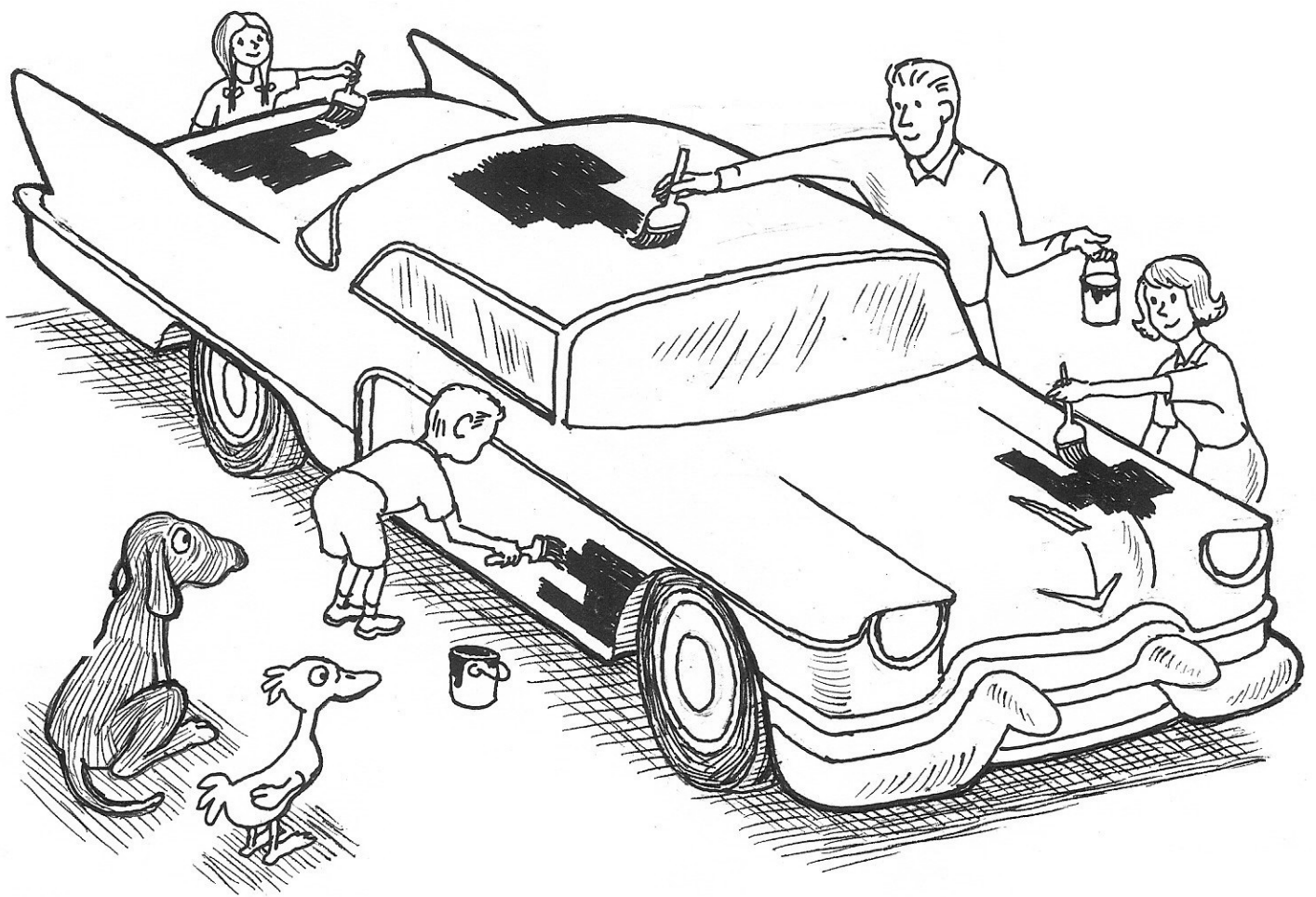
So he lifted Mack's ear and said, "QUACK! QUACK!"



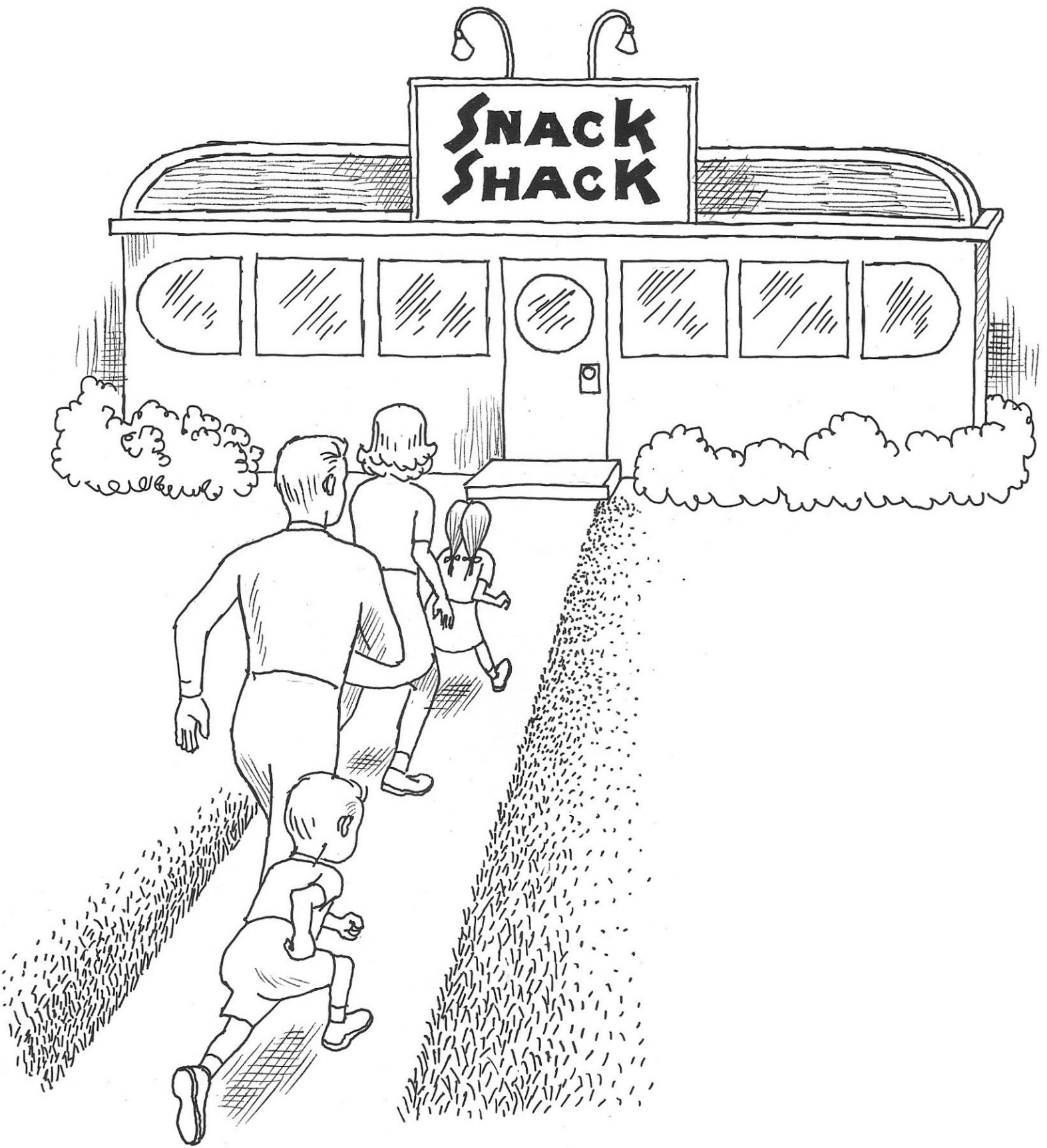
What a cute little pet is our duck, Jack Quack.
But look who's jealous - our dog, Black Mack.



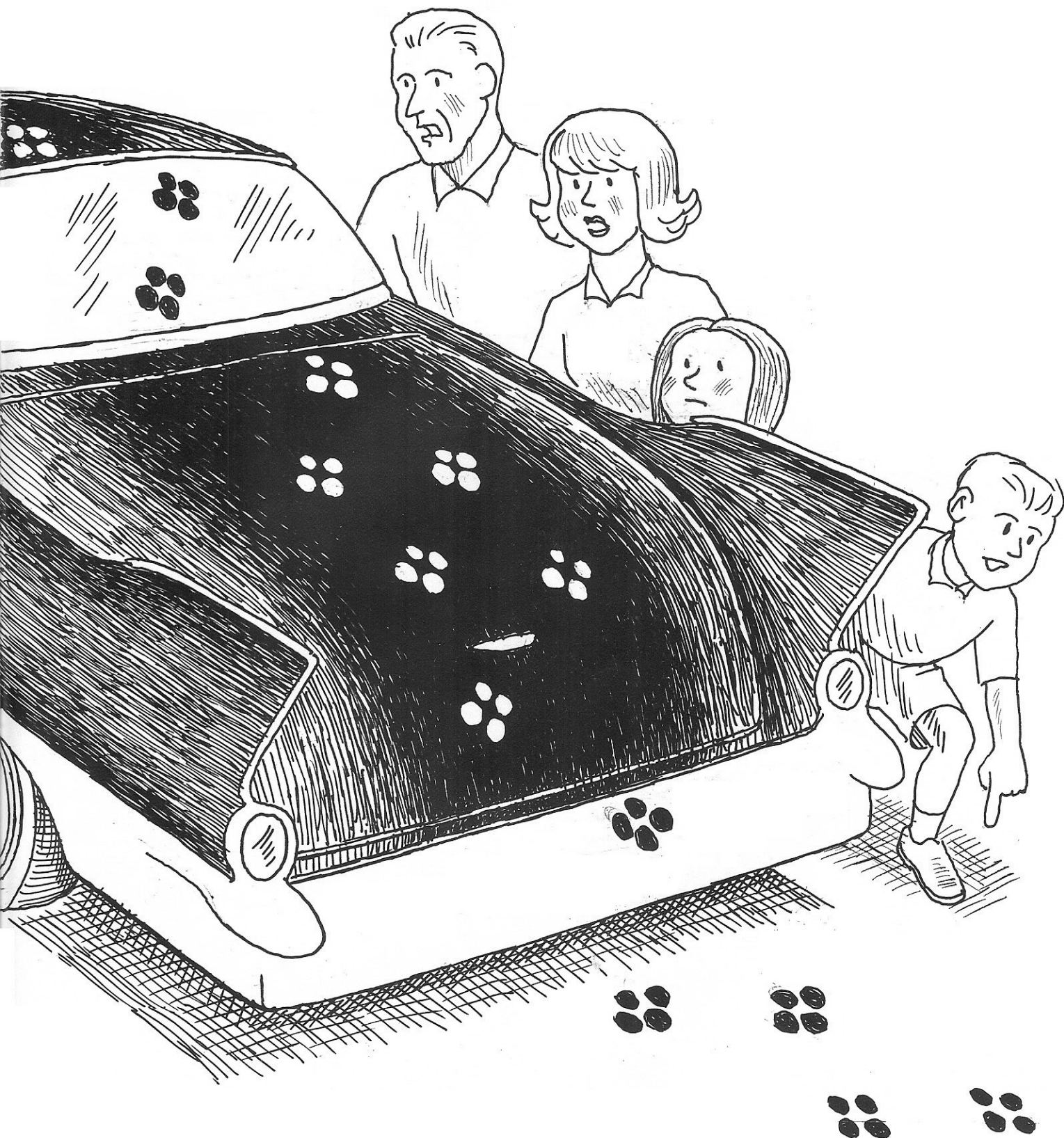
Now, he doesn't DARE to attack Jack Quack.

One day we painted our cadillac black..



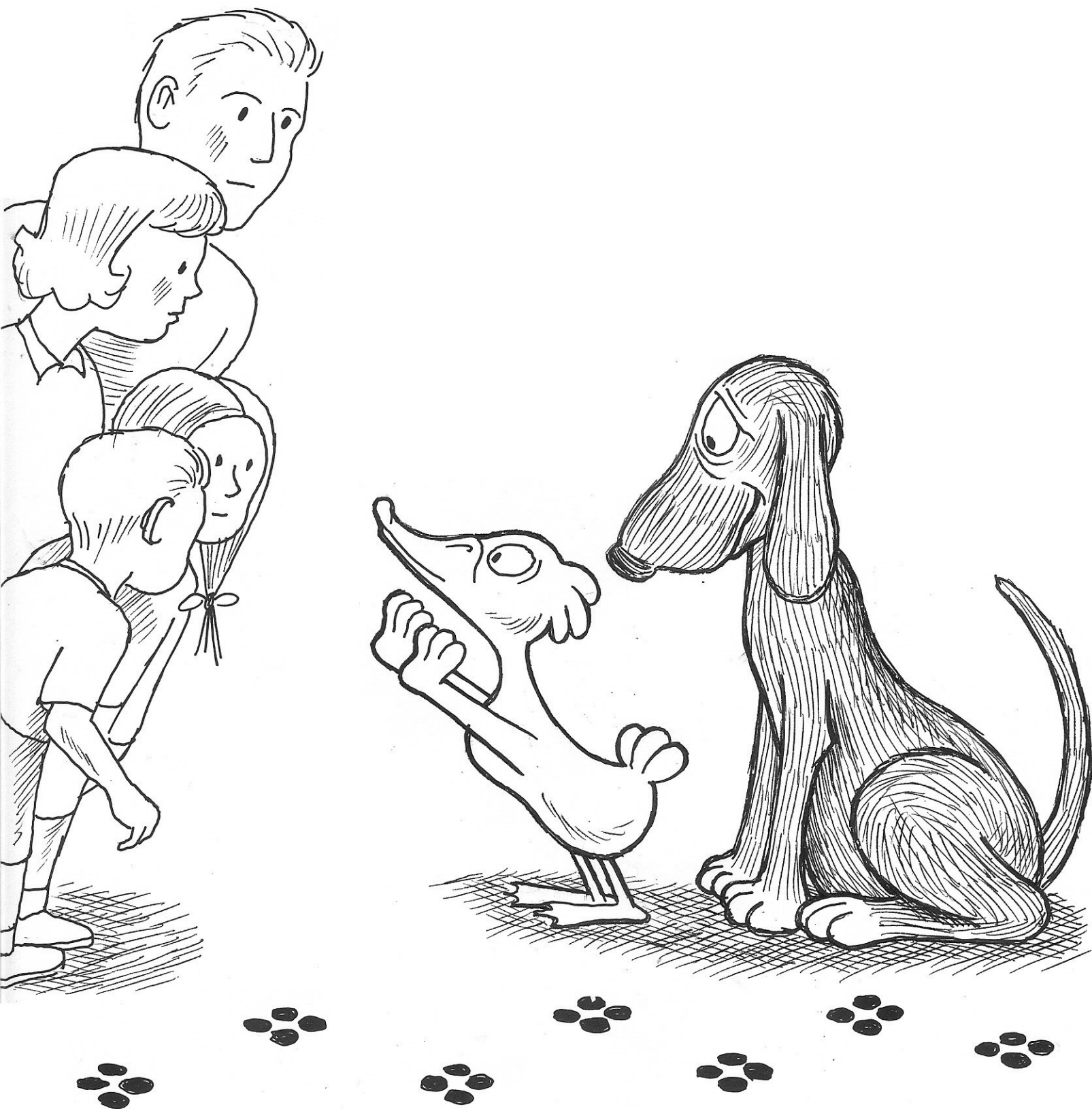
Then walked to lunch at the local Snack Shack.



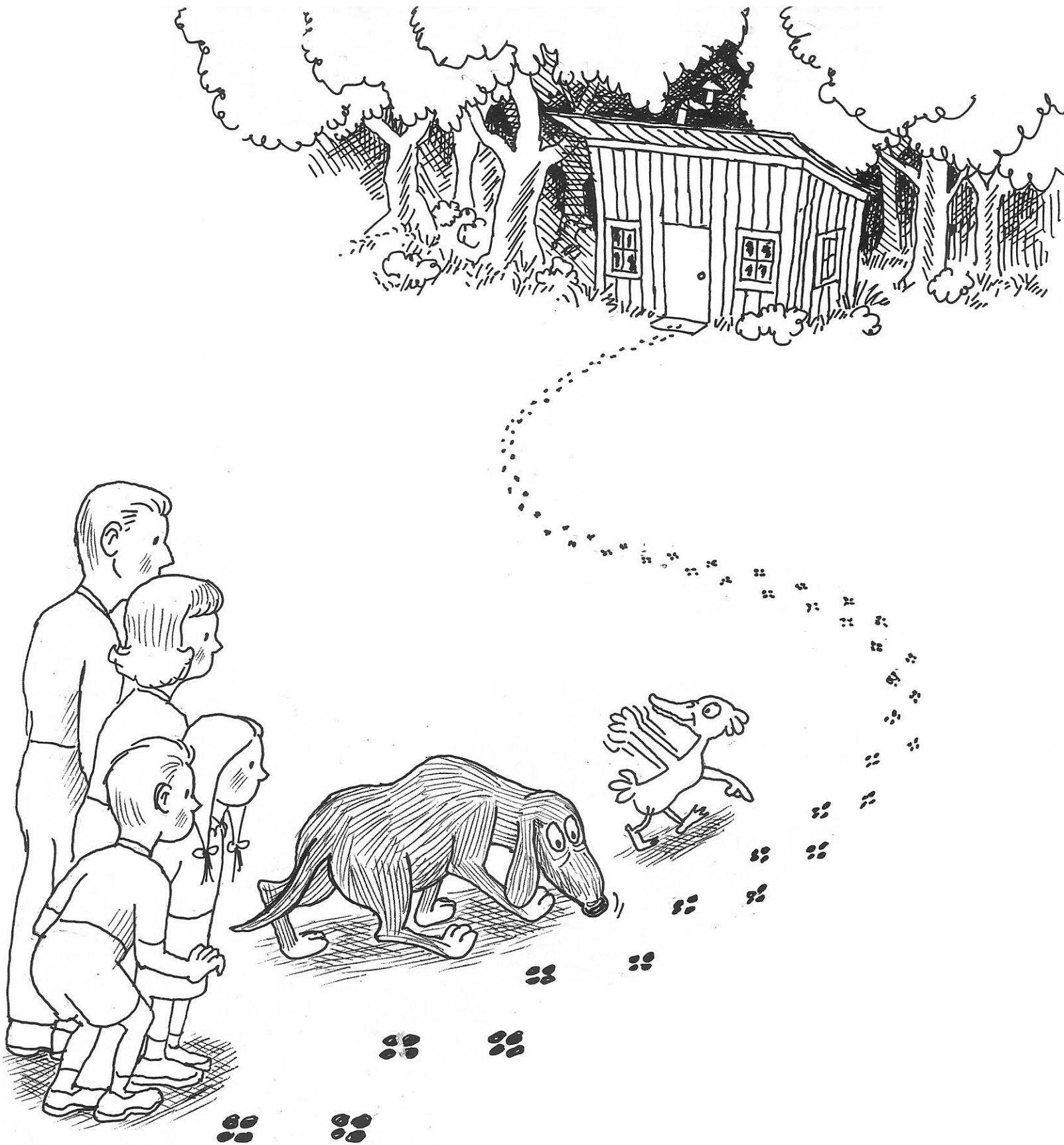
But when we returned, we found a black track
That came right off the cadillac back!



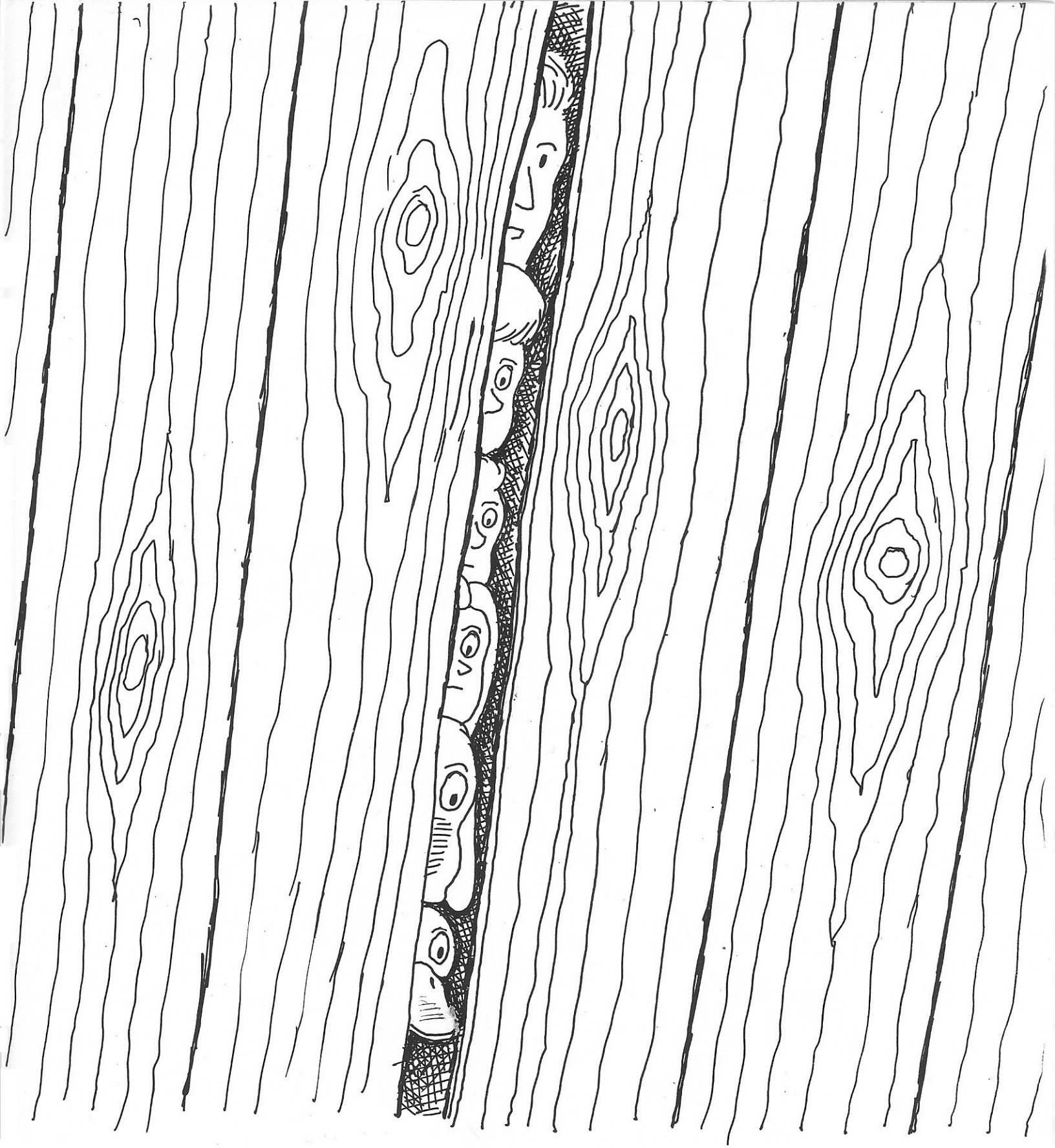
We know who did it. Our dog, Black Mack.
Oh! We were mad! But we didn't whack Mack.....



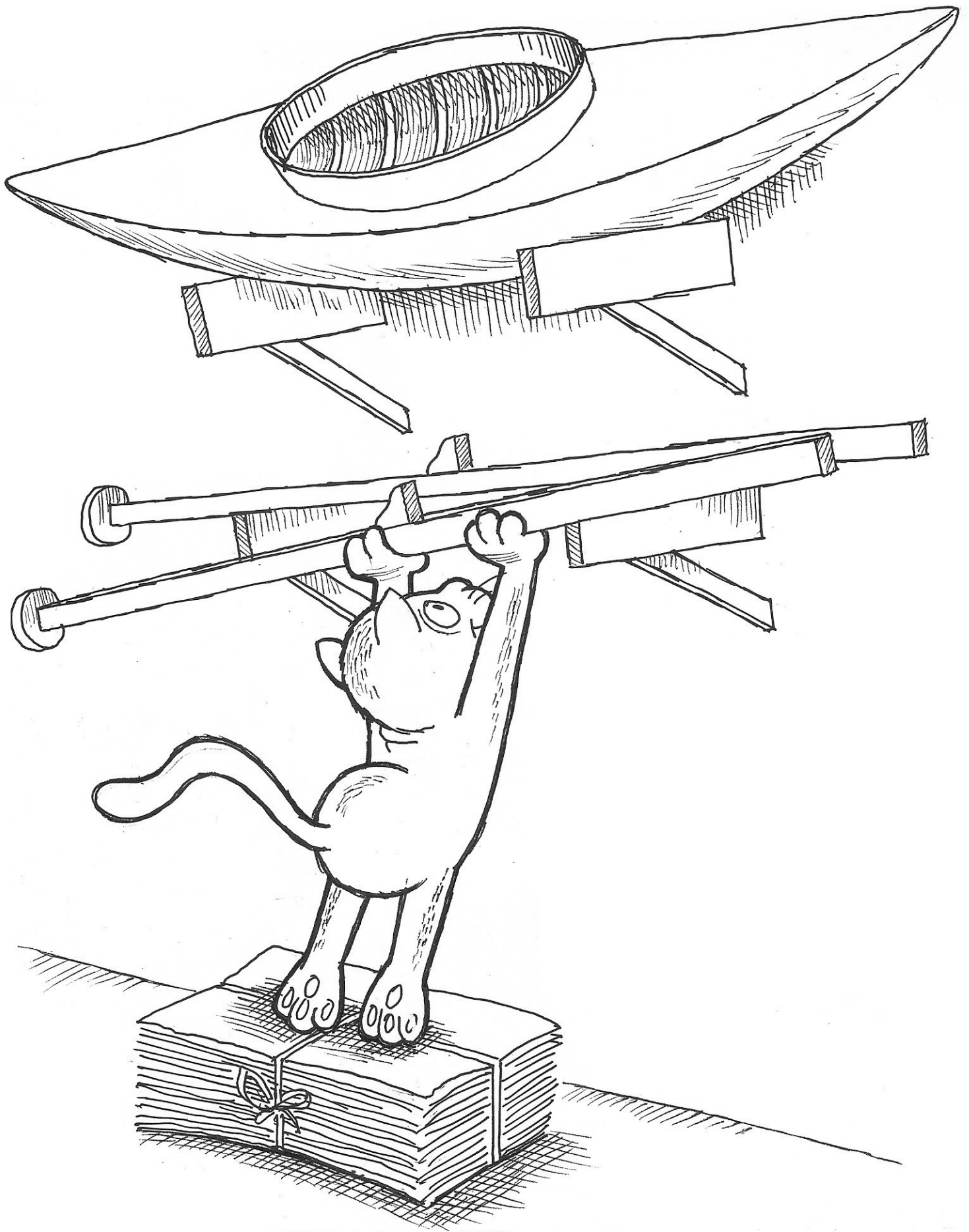
Blocking the way was our duck, Jack Quack.



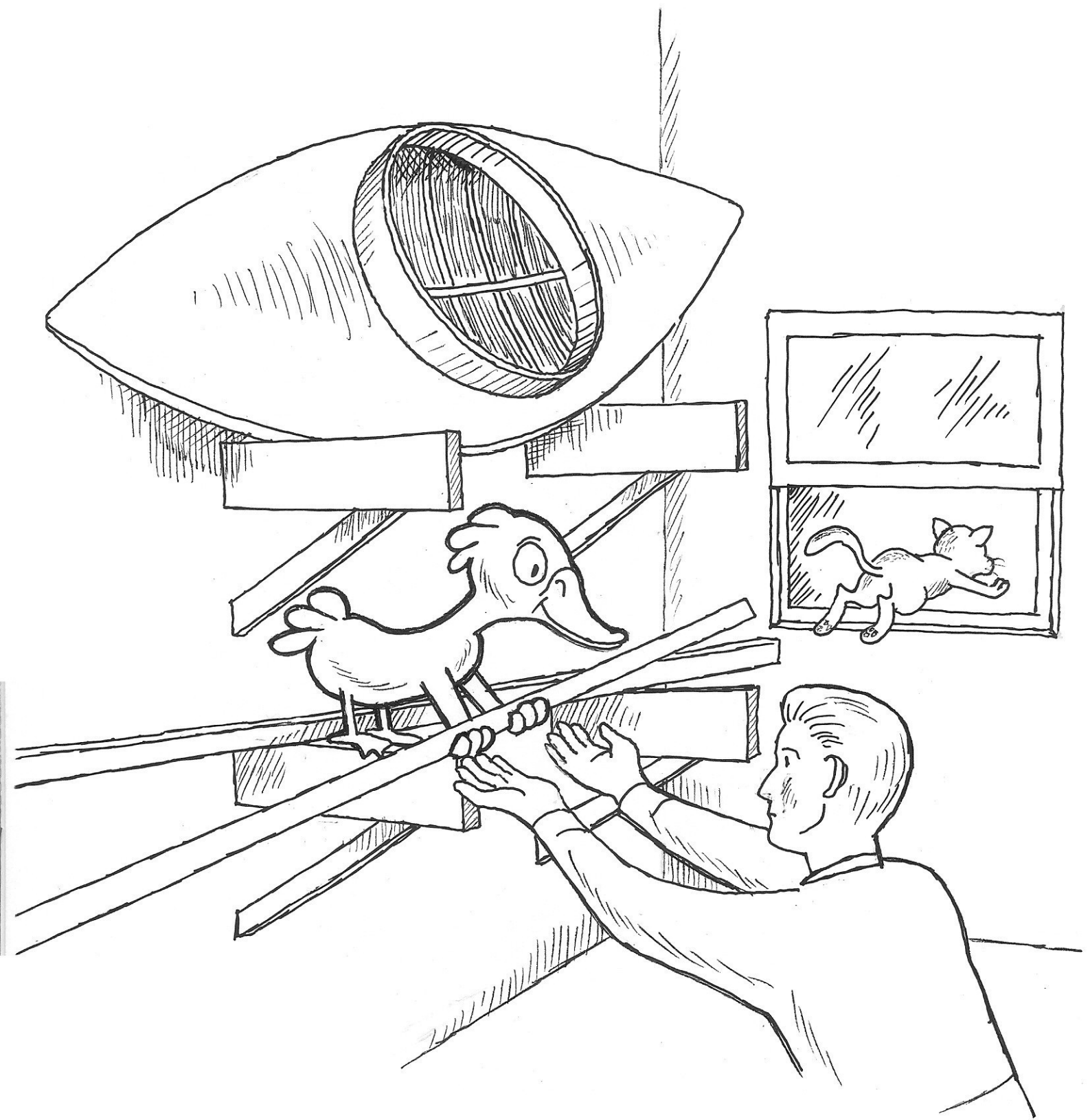
He waved and pointed and said, QUACK! QUACK!

There we peered through a wide shack crack.....



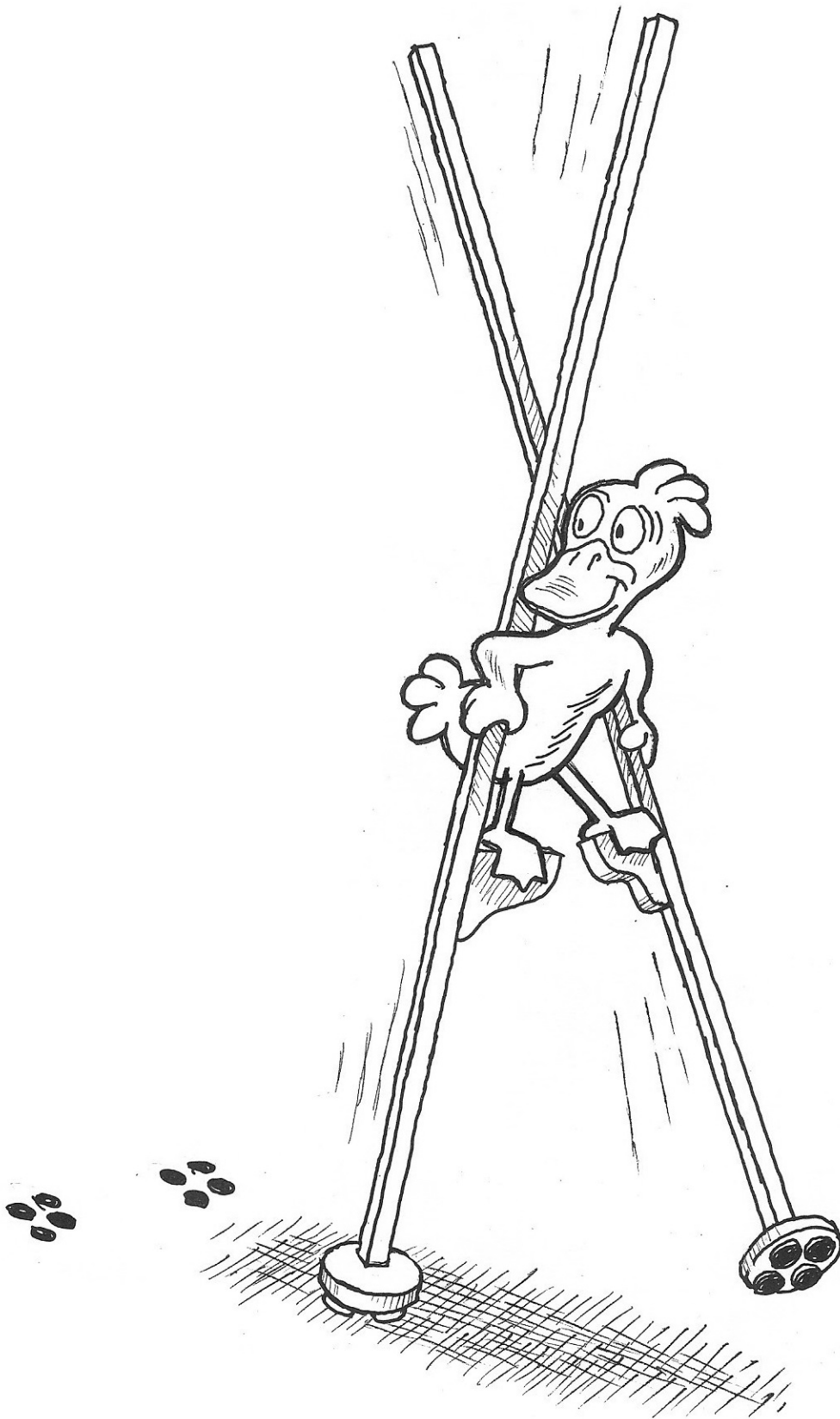
And saw a cat on a paper sack pack.
She was hiding something on a kayak rack.



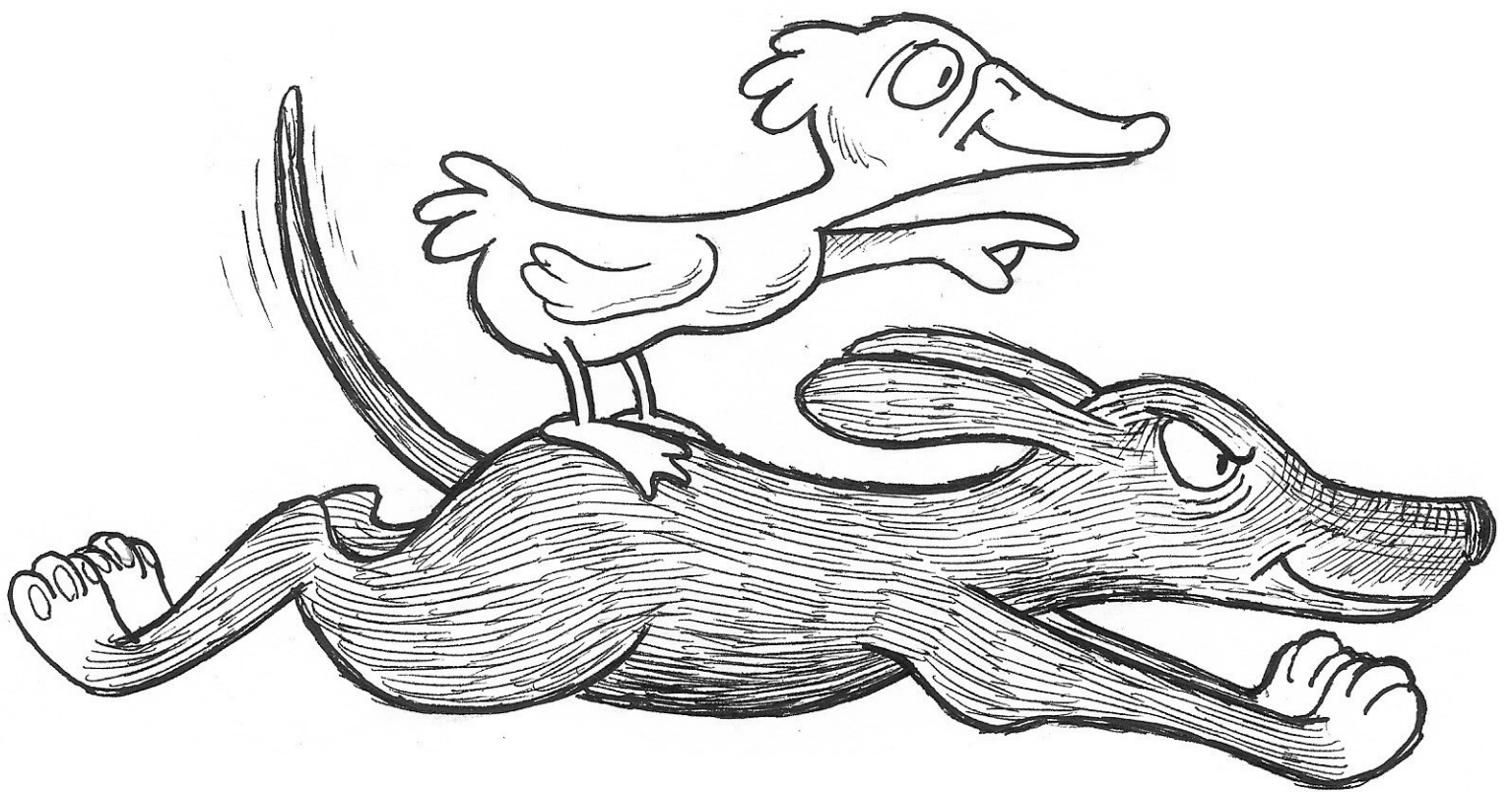
Now our neighbor's cat simply HATED Black Mack.
So what was she hiding on the kayak rack?



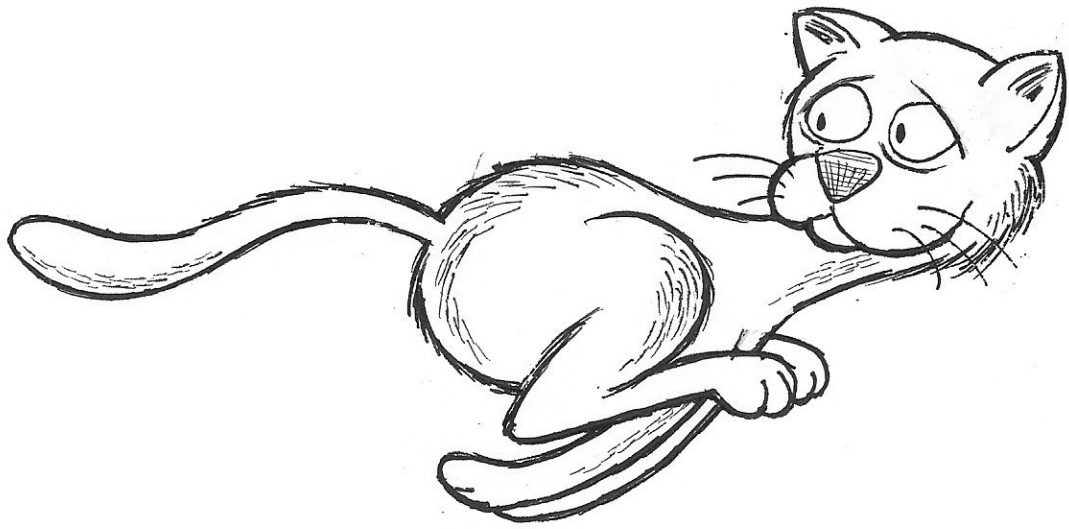
Well, look at that!

For over 35 years he has delighted children of preschool to 7 years of age with books that have made learning fun. His series, TALK-ALONG, was published in 1982 and was the first interactive books introduced into the schools. They were best sellers because they taught basic concepts in a very original and clever way, and all in rhyme. He wrote another series called DOUBLE-RHYME, and over the years he has added to both series and also written single story books. Of the 15 books he has authored, seven of them are also illustrated by him. Because he spent a number of years as a writer-cartoonist for a Hollywood animation studio, his illustrations have a special appeal for children. They are perky, funny and expressive.
